



World Congress for People Who Stutter 2019



Application for Scholarship

ISA scholarships are open to international visitors to this conference and must be made by 31 March 2019.

Financial assistance will only cover fees for registration and accommodation. Any and all other expenses including flights, gala dinner, transport and other recreational activities will need to be organized directly by you at your own expense. Funds will not be exchanged for alternative accommodations. Meals for breakfast and lunch during the congress are included as part of the accommodation and congress fees (from breakfast 24 June to breakfast 27 June).

To support your application for scholarship funding, on a separate page you will:

- 1) Explain why you wish to attend the congress and why you request financial support.
- 2) In advance of the conference, produce a video up to 5 minutes in length (loaded to YouTube) talking about how you interact with your local stuttering community and how you intend to communicate the information you learn during the congress (if you do not have the resources to produce a video then provide the information in written form, not more than 500 words) – note that your application must include this, and
- 3) After the congress, provide a written article (with photos). This will be published in One Voice, the magazine of the ISA, to share what you learnt, how it will help your local stuttering community and how you will communicate your learnings with others in your country.
